Welcome to the EB-3 Visa Program

Are you willing to make the United States your permanent home?

The EB-3 visa program might be the perfect avenue for you. This brochure is designed to provide you with comprehensive information about the EB-3 visa process, eligibility requirements, and the steps involved in obtaining lawful permanent residency in the United States.

What is the EB-3 Visa Program?

The EB-3 visa program is an employment-based immigration program that allows certain skilled workers, professionals, and unskilled workers to obtain lawful permanent residency (green card) in the United States. It is divided into three subcategories:

1. EB-3A (Skilled Workers):

- The applicant requires minimum 2 years of job experience or 2 years training in similar field or relevant Post-secondary education that may be considered as training.
- The applicant must meet the educational requirements specified for that particular job.

2. EB-3B (Professional)

- The applicant who has U.S Baccalaureate or Foreign equivalent degree and the member of the profession in similar field.

3. EB-3C (Other Workers/ Unskilled Workers)

- The applicant who has less than 2 years training or experience.

Key Features of the EB-3 Visa Program

Employer Sponsorship: Applicants must have a permanent job offer from a U.S. employer who is willing to sponsor their immigration petition.

Labor Certification: Employer must obtain a Labor Certification to demonstrate that there are no qualified U.S. worker available for the position.

Key Features of the EB-3 Visa Program (Continued)

File Form I-140: Employer files Immigrant Petition (I-140) for Alien Worker, with USCIS on behalf of applicant.

Consular Processing: Proceed with DS-260 submission and confirmation from embassy.

Receive Green Card: Upon approval of application, green card will be received by granting lawful permanent residency in the United States.

Step-4: Apply for Labor Certification

Step-5: Immigration petition filing (I-140)

Step-6: Consular processing (DS-260 submission and confirmation from Embassy)
